 - 2 seats will be allotted to Dalit Catholics of Kannur Diocese. Unfilled seat will be reverted to Christian Community Merit seats.
 - 2 seats will be allotted to religious nuns of any Catholic religious congregation. Unfilled seats will be reverted to Christian Community Merit seats.
